

NOVELTIES AND SPECIALTIES

AMARYLLIS Belladonna, a beautiful Lily-like plant blooming in Summer before the foliage starts.

AQUILEGIA Pearson's Crimson Star, new, rich crimson sepals and spurs, pure white petals, fine.

Vulgaris Double, Rod Riding Hood, pure white corolla with old rose calyx, a charming variety.

ARMERIA Formosa Giant Hybrids, hp, 15in. A mass of leafy tufts during Winter from which strong scapes issue, surmounted by large globes of lovely firs, bright colors from blush to dark carmine.

CACTUS, a splendid mixture containing many fine species and varieties; a liberal packet only 5 cts.

CALCEOLARIA Multiflora Nana, lft. Compact, showy sprays of small firs in gay colors and markings.

CALENDULA "Shaggy" i8in. Distinct, big, flat, rich orange, fluffy, Chrysanthemum-like dble firs.

CANTERBURY Bell Liberty- Blooms in 6 months, large intense blue bells throughout the season.

Angelus Bell, like Liberty but lovely deep rose. I urge every patron to get these bells.

CARDINAL Climber, hha, 20ft. A hybrid Ipomoea similar to Cypress Vine, but more robust and having larger more showy firs; good trellis vine. 25 s.

CARNATION, Somerset Lady, a perpetual blooming border Carnation, immense double white flowers, on long stems, hardy, richly scented.

CHRYSANTHEMUM Nivellii, aft. A handsome bushy

annual covered with golden flowers 2 or 3 inches across.

CINERARIA Miuiature, lft. Firs small in compact masses, rich colors and markings.

CUT-FLOWER, Garden Mixture. Hardy *annuals* making a showy bed and yielding cut-flowers throughout the season. 1-4 oz. 7 5 c. 1 oz. 15c lb 50c.

GAILLARDIA, Indian Chief, ha, lft. Everblooming, big broad-rayed firs., sparkling bronzed on long stems, in bloom all Summer; wonderfully showy in beds and fine for cutting.

HELIANTHEMUM Mutabile, hp, lft., indispensable rock plants for sunny places; cup-like firs; in many colors; new and beautiful sorts mixed. 50 s. Rotundifolium, hp, 1 f t., fine sun-loving plant with pretty deep carmine firs. in Summer.

Rich colors in splendid mixture, fine for pots: Sybil Sherwood, 2ft., big trusses of salmon-pink flowers edged white, fine for pots or beds.

LARKSPUR, Giant Imperial Mac Donald's Improved Spiral; ha, 5ft. Glorious 4ft. trusses, Blue Bell, Lavender, Vivid Salmon Rose. Most showy, charming, finest annual Larkspurs known.

LEUCANTHEMUM Shasty Daisy, new giant double, white firs 5in. across, fine stems, hardy, for cutting.

LUPINUS Armageddon, hp, 4ft. Rich deep blue shaded Heavenly blue, showy, very beautiful, fine. Effective, 4ft- Branching, violet, yellow and white. New King, ha, 4ft. Great spiral clusters of large firs, exquisite oxford blue, and spotless pure white, elegant in beds, *fine* for cutting; see engraving.

MARIGOLD African, Bodger's Golden Emblem, 2f t. Finest of African Marigolds. Huge lemon-orange quilled flowers; everblooming.

NASTURTIUM "Scarlet Gleam," true; bears freely, very large, dazzling orange-scarlet, sweet flowers. "Glorious Gleam Hybrids" big long stems, double

firs in rarest, richest Colors mixed. See pg. 2 cover.

NEMESIA, Superbissima New Dwarf, fine large firs.

NICOTIANA Snowstorm, 18 in. Compact masses of miniature snow-white starry firs- Showy and deliciously scented. Fine for beds and pots; open all day; a rare good thing for every flower lover.

PENTSTEMON Baby Hybrids, 2 ft. New; long, graceful sprays of miniature "Gloxuias". Fine to cut.

Heterophyllus Blue Gem, 18in. Lovely blue, rocky

PETUNIA Balcony Damask Rose. Dazzling sensational spectrum red; most brilliant of drooping Petunias; flowers four inches across- Giant Double Fringed. Huge pink feather balls edged white; a glorious double Petunia, 6 in. across. Giant Double Fringed Rose Queen, 5in. feather balls, splendid bright rose; a glorious Petunia.

Nana Compacts Pink Gem. A new race; plants 6 in, smothered with small pink firs., for pots, borders.

Periwinkle, lft. Compact, a profusion of lovely blue flowers, large, bold, five-pointed.

POPPY Begonia-flowered. Full double frilled firs• like Begonias, transplants well; pink, rose, salmon in splendid mixture.

Nudicaule El Monte, enormous long stemmed firs, extremely easily grown; blooms in 6 months; fine.

PRIMULA Elatior, Bright Eyes. Yellow to orange flowers, distinct scarlet eye, fluted petals, a beautiful hardy perennial.

I SOLANUM Hendersonii, 1 ft. A popular Jerusalem Cherry, scarlet berries, profuse, handsome, easily grown showy window plant.

Hlavacek's, compact, showy with red cherries.

STATIS Sinuata, improved brilliant deep blue flowers on 3 feet stems, invaluable for cutting.

SWEET WILLIAM, Purple Beauty, 2 ft. Big heads of very sweet flowers; richest purple, new, fine.

VERBENA Cerise Queen, lft. Compact masses of huge trusses of firs one and a fourth inches across; beautiful soft salmon cerise; something new.

Spectrum Red, lft. The brightest of all Verbenas, dazzling scarlet; lustrous and beautiful, florets more than an inch across; in large heads; a charming outstanding Verbena.

VIOLA Cornuta, Lord Beaconsfield- Large flowers, purple standards, lower petals white penciled blue Apricot, Bin. A rare tufted Pansy, rich apricot, orange center, large long stemmed firs; showy- **VIRGINIA** Stock, Crimson Gem, lft. Compact erect plants; profuse; a gem for beds or rockery.

ZINNIA Kelway's Super-giant Comet, 8 in. Double, richest crimson flowers; fine for beds and cutting.
