New Charming Carmine Globe Verbena

A good compact dwarf Verbena superior for beds has long been in demand and I am pleased to offer here a splendid variety that "fills the bill." The plants start readily, quickly come into bloom, and branch freely at the base forming a mass of leafy stems, each tipped with a huge cluster of bloom, color bright lustrous carmine, vivid and beautiful- The plants form a globe ten inches high and one foot across, dense and literally covered with bloom-clusters throughout the season- Often from 50 to 60 trusses open at one time. Nothing in the way of a bedding Verbena approaches the beauty and showiness of this elegant variety. But while so valuable for beds or borders, it is equally adapted for pot culture and is a charming window plant for Winter blooming as well as for porch decoration in Summer- You should have this magnificent Verbena.
