When the *Monstrosa* varieties of *Bellis Perennis*, the double English Daisy, were developed we thought the last stage of improvement that splendid perennial had been reached; but here comes that German hybridizer, Fritz Hufeld, with a Super-Giant race that surpasses all others. He calls it "Le Grand Fuselier," and describes it as follows:

This is the largest English Daisy in existence. The enormous full-double flowers give rather the idea of a finely-formed Double Aster than that of an English Daisy. The first flowers measure from two to two and a half inches in diameter, being borne on strong stems a foot in length- This race

They are gorgeous in beds and equally desirable for pots or in the greenhouse- The flowers are fragrant and come in all shades and variegations; they are exceedingly attractive and very desirable for cutting as the trusses are on long leafy stems and last well when cut. These Snapdragons are about as near perfection as can be obtained. They have developed every element of a first class flower and are of easy culture, the seeds starting readily and the plants growing freely even under adverse conditions. They are hardy and will endure the Winters if not allowed to exhaust themselves blooming the first season. If you buy only a half-dozen packets of flower seeds this year, one of them should be mixed Majestic Snapdragons.
