Aster

Bodger's Mammoth Perfection, finest of double Asters. Surpasses all others in size, range of colors, doubleness, perfect form and showiness; glorious in beds and unsurpassed for cutting. seeds direct from Badgers.



Bartonia

Aurea. A beautiful annual, lovely in both foliage and flowers; cup-shaped about 3 in. across, filled with long showy stamens; color, a bright metallic yellow, exceedingly brilliant in the sunshine; thrives in moist sandy loam, but suffers in a drouth.



Abram

Umbellata Grandiflora, Sand Verbena. A fine trailing plant with clusters of lovely lilac firs. Likes sand and sun. Fine for covering bare spots or for the rockery, also desirable for beds or borders, and hanging baskets; blooms a long time; does well in poor soil. Remove husks before sowing. 20 s.

Balsam

Benary
Balsams are as double as Camellias; are like Camellias in form, waxy in texture, and of the most varied colors. Mr. Benary has given this flower his special attention for years, and his strain is unsurpassed. Plants 20 inches high, becoming wreaths of rich flowers. Don't omit this.



Erysimum

Golden Gem. A splendid little annual 1 foot high. Sown in early spring plants become a mass of rich golden firs. in Autumn, endures the Winter and blooms again in the Spring, or can be sown in Autumn; superb for an edging or the rockery and glorious in beds. It thrives in good soil or partial shade.

;Coxcomb

Benary's Improved Dwarf. Glasgow Prize Coxcomb is a splendid bedding plant. Seedlings start easily, begin to bloom early, and improve in beauty till frost. Set 8 in. apart.
A foot broad seen against the lovely foliage is showy and greatly admired. Seeds direct from Benary. Fine for pots.



Asperula

Azurea Setosa. is a very pretty annual with whorls of bristly leaves and clusters of lovely sky-blue flowers that are deliciously fragrant. A handsome plant for the rockery, desirable for groups or borders, also excellent for cutting. This little plant is easily grown from seeds.

Gaillardia

Gaillardia Lorenziana ft. pl. is an everblooming annual a foot high, branching, each branch bearing a big dble. flower, like a Calendula, lasting for weeks. Colors: white, yellow, red, cream, red tipped with white, scarlet with white tip. All in Benary's special mixture I offer. Plants bloom till winter.



Datura

Ceratocaula. This fine, showy annual is 3 feet high, bearing large in pink and white colors. Plants start readily from seeds, branch and are covered from early summer until frost with their sweet-scented blooms. Fine for a background or border.

Annual Phlox

Dummond's Phlox, a favorite for many years, has been greatly improved. The plants are now dwarf and compact, produce larger flowers in larger trusses, and the new colors and variegations are marvelous. For pots or beds they are glorious masses of rich bloom; last for months; showy and beautiful



Cosmea

Mammoth Late. These Autumn-blooming plants produce thousands of artistic firs., furnishing an abundance of bloom for Autumn decoration. Sow in spring in the open ground, when danger of frost is past, or start plants in a box and light soil, but not too rich.

Schizanthus

Recently improved hybrids of Schizanthus have been introduced, but their flowers never appealed to me until the Chislehurst Giant Hybrids appeared, and I confess it was a case of "love at first sight". I enthusiastically declared they surpass all others. Get seeds I recom-mend; you will thank me.
